Evolution - across the years (millions)

See and understand the pattern

Advertisers - a number of ads = a number of sales

2. Both within us - sowing there

Old Indian illustration - two dogs fight within, good dog and the bad dog - which one wins? - the one I feed the most

3. We sow

Parents sow seeds

- -seeds of indifference
- -seeds of good or bad tempers
- -good or bad attitudes
- -selfishness

Christian sow seeds

- -Jesus answer or not
- -service or not

Ex - William Carey in India - out from where he lived plants grow not native to India - wind blew seeds from Carey's home

-ideas and thinking of our world

Church attitudes

- -toward missions
- -toward their church
- -toward their staff
- -friendly or not

Others have sown in your thinking

- -books you've read influence you
- -friends you've made influence you
- -problems you've had influence you

Ex - experienced pain become compassionate

- -teachers you've listened to influence you
- -pastors you've sat under influence you
- -television influences you
- 4. We can choose what we sow intentionally

Ex - I have no corn in my front yard - did you plant any?

Have nothing then planted nothing

Plant watching the bachelorettes ...?

5. So, sow

- -when you do can expect a harvest
- -sow in practical habits
 - -bible carrying a vote for the bible
 - -prayer
 - -being friendly
- -attitudes are sown others will
 - -people get a feel for how you are and your attitudes

3. A Logical Harvest

- 1. The principle ... Ties results/ harvest to sowing
 - -rather ties our results to our sowing
 - -!!). in some ways that's a scary idea...
 - -what if I mess up?
 - -it's possible
 - -see it as free will in the garden
 - -till your garden
 - -remove your weeds
 - -fertilize
 - -Next... what will I plant?

So... in the garden of your life what will you plant?

2. Very simple logic
