- 2. The story tells how Israel came to migrate into Egypt
- 3. Introduced to Joseph
 - -was he the "perfect" character/ brother?
 - 1) cannot help but see Christ here
 - 2) sold out by brothers, received of father, in the dungeon (death) and out
 - -was he a spoiled younger brother?
 - 1) bad report to dad
 - 2) reports dreams in your face?
 - 3) tests brothers by putting cup in their food bag -?
- 4. Everybody transforms
 - -Joseph to an Egyptian official who "saves" his brothers
 - -brothers to maturity and watch care status

I. Jacob and Joseph (1-4)

- 1. Seventeen (2)
- 2. Loved more (3)

Coat of many colors (3)

-follow the coat... when removed... the brothers are removing his "love"

-RSV - "he made him a long robe with sleeves" - did not have to work

Son of Rachel

Comfort in Jacob's old age

 - -"hated" him -4
 - -"hated" him all the more -8
 - -brothers "envied" him -11
 - -the "dreamer" comes 19 (sarcasm)

              -is Reuben a leader? Is this guilt? (the eldest, the responsible one)
              -Reuben has his own plot (to avoid the killing of his brother)

              -spices, balm and myrrh (25)

              -Judah is the eldest
       5. Sold (28)
VII. Reuben Returns (29-35)
       1. Reuben's grief
              -sincerely sorry - at 29 he rent his clothes
              -"whither shall I go?" (30)
       2. Dip the coat in blood

Selling him Lie to dad

3. Is this your son's coat?
-what a clever lie

- -Jacob jumps to a conclusion
- 4. Jacob grieves
 - -refused to be comforted
 - -they did away with the despised brother, but not the love Jacob had for him

VIII. What about Joseph? (36)

- 1. Sold to Potiphar, an "officer" of the Pharaoh
 - -and "captain" of the guard
- 2. Put his chosen one into a place of protection (from his own brothers)
