1. Be Careful How You Lead (1-2)

- A. Just discussed issues they'd brought up -
 - -Pharisees misled
 - -don't be like Pharisees who lead others into sin
- B. Leadership is important
- C. "Woe" "watch out" but stronger
 - -strong, serious
- D. **Danger** of misleading

Held accountable for money

Doubly held accountable for leadership

2. Always be Ready to Forgive (3-4)

- A. "Take heed to yourselves"
 - -looks at Pharisees be careful
 - -to yourselves
- B. Active forgiveness
 - -as you're sinned against
 - -suppose he comes to you seven times forgive him
- !!). Two ways around:
 - 1) That means I can quit at 8, right?
 - 2) Has to ask for forgiveness to happen -yeah but

Father forgive them

- C. Make forgiveness a lifestyle
 - -says something upset forgive
 - -doesn't do what expect upset, forgive
 - -attacks of Satan upset, forgive (through Peter?)
 - -some haven't ever come to grips with parent failure forgive
- D. **D***ebt* of forgiveness
 - -because we've been forgiven, we owe forgiveness

3. Faith is a Seed (5-6)

A. Train of thought

Don't be like a Pharisee

Take head to yourselves

Forgive like that? - how in the world?

- B. How in the world? I need more faith increase our faith
 - !!). two things the disciples asked for "teach us to pray" more "faith"
- C. "Faith" trust -faith as the power to be/ do right
 - -increase my spirituality my spiritual life
- D. "Grow our faith!"
 - -isn't this the way it always is?
 - -circumstances led into which demand more from us than we have
 - -have to lean on God

Example - your life bills, don't know how - trust, pray

-"help me" - faith grows as you see God provide

Example - asked to teach a class - "help me"

-more than ever - trust, ask, faith grows

Example - asked to change jobs

- -what am I gonna do
- -led to a place never been before
- -faith grows

D. *Dynamic* of faith

God's will, will never lead you where His grace cannot sustain you Get stretched - find out how big God is

!!). How much does it take - a grain, just a little grain

4. A Servants Duty is to Serve (7-10)

- A. Circumstances
 - -all day
 - -comes in, asked to serve more
 - -to do extra
- B. Humility
 - -his task, his assignment
 - -my job...
 - -it doesn't matter if anyone else does asked me
 - -it doesn't matter if anyone sees asked me
 - -it doesn't matter if I succeed asked me
- C. We get to serve the King of Kings
 - -you and I are so blessed
 - -saved
 - -if that's not enough, use me to lead a class or help with committee
- D. That's the *Duty* of service
 - -"duty" as a good thing
 - -very honorable

First trip to Canary Islands

-this passage came to life - Luke 17 - we've only done what is our duty*

Woe to offenders - their sin

Take heed to yourselves

I need more faith!
