- 1. A lesson we all need to learn
 - -computers
 - -fast-food
 - -cell phones, don't have to wait til we get home to call
 - -microwaves
- 2. We are impatient
 - -with people, children, husbands, wives
 - -with circumstances (when will I ever get that job?)
 - -with our own bodies (when will I ever lose weight? When will I ever get well?)
 - -with God (prayers answered, harvest come in, his return, when will the
 - unrighteous "get theirs?"
 - -with our dentist/ doctor
 - -with the restaurant
 - -with the stop light/ traffic jams
- 2. A right now generation: instant gratification -programed to be impatient?

I. Exhortation to Patience

- 1. Impatience Causes Sin
 - A. 5:9 grudges
 - B. 5:12 swear
 - C. 5:8 instability
 - D. When the people saw that Moses "delayed" Ex. 32:1
 - E. Abraham, set aside God's means took Hagar
 - F. We are short-sighted
 - G. Impatience is insubordination form of self-will
- 2. Patience brings God's blessing:
 - A. Ps. 40:1
 - B. Is. 25:9
 - C. Is. 26:8
 - D. Is. 33:2
 - E. Acts 1:4
 - F. *Luke 8:15 good-ground hearers bring forth fruit with patience
- 3. Patience is Practical
 - A. Ushers in good manners
 - B. Not "touchy" irritable not easily provoked.
 - C. Seeks for best in others.

II. Example of Patience

- 1. Example of the **Farmer** (7-8)
 - A. Points to God's time-table
 - B. Baby cannot talk at 3 days

- C. Nothing to do with bad or good child
- 2. Example of the **Prophets** (10)
 - A. Points to our heritage
 - B. Points to our calling
 - C. Prophecy yet nothing happened
 - D. Persecuted
- 3. Example of **Job** (11)
 - A. Points to the result God gets glory
 - B. Shall I receive good at the Lord's hand and not evil?
- 4. Example of **Christ**
 - A. Wearied spoke with Samaritan Jn. 4
 - B. With disciples "carest not"
 - C. My time is not come Jn. 7
 - D. Reviled not again

III. Expectation of Patience

- 1. Necessary to receive the promises Heb. 11
- 2. **Internally** receive James 1:4
 - A. You're being perfected, completed matured
 - B. Puts us in possession of our souls Luke 21:9
- 3. Externally receive Heb. 10:36
 - A. Farmer receives rain
 - B. Verse 11 end of the Lord
- 4. Eternally receive James 5:7
 - A. Verse 7 unto the coming of the Lord
 - B. Verse 8 coming of the Lord draws nigh
- 5. How long must I be patient? "until the coming of the Lord"

IV. Explanation of Patience

- 1. Patience is a fruit/ not a gift
 - A. Subtle distinction
 - B. Splitting hairs
- 2. Patience is grown not given
 - *We want what God gives not who He is
- 3. As our relationship with Him is right it is a by-product
