Comparing and Contrasting the Shepherds and Wise Men

Shepherds - sent an angel - a personal word/ announcement Wise Men - sent a star (not very personal)

Wise men - seeking out Shepherds - sought out

What would the wise men have done with an angelic message?

Wise men - unbelievers who became believers (star) Shepherds - already Jewish believers (angels)

## Grace:

Don't miss the "grace"

Star to wise men - given

Angel to the Shepherds - given

Message found <u>them</u> then <u>they</u> had to find Jesus (the baby)

On the one hand it's true - God comes to them (not they going to God) - it's also true that when they received the word, they both (wise men and shepherds) went to "check it out"

God's done His part - so what's our part?

Good Christmas/ Bad Christmas

- -what makes the difference?
- -are we passive in enjoying Christmas?
- -is there a part of Christmas that's up to us?

## **Communication** - between heaven and earth

- -Star language
- -Angel language

God speaks a new language here - the message of stars

God gave the message to mistrusted shepherds vs the Pharisees, or an "Isaiah" type. Seems a little "unholy" to me. So does God communicate with the "unholy?"

## **Today** - applications

- 1. Note the "check it out mentality"
  - -why don't people check Jesus out today often they say "well, I know those people at the church, -they aren't any better than I am."
- 2. Most would miss a star today... you'd have to look up

- -do you ever look at the stars
  3. Modern scientists would be carried away with a new star but miss its significance
  4. Complete absence of any "holly men" messengers or prophets -not till John the Baptist
